LDM Program Specific Withdrawal and Cancellation Policies:

LdM Semester Housing Cancellation Policy:

45 days or MORE prior to the check-in date: the \$300 security deposit and \$1,200 of the rent payment will be refunded.

44-31 days preceding the check-in date, the student will lose the security deposit (\$300) but will be refunded the \$1,200 of the rent payment.

30-11 days preceding the check-in date, the student is liable for the \$300 security deposit and \$1,200 of the rent payment.

10-0 days preceding the check-in date or if student fails to check-in to their housing assignment, the student is responsible for the full rental amount of the

LDM Tuition Cancellation Policy (If an official cancellation notice is received by LdM):

45-31 days prior to the beginning of the term, the student will be liable for \$500 of tuition.

30-0 days prior to the beginning of the term, the student will be liable for half of the tuition cost.

If the student withdraws after the start of the program, liability amounts to full tuition and no refund will be made.

The student will be fully liable for the total tuition cost if no official notice of the student's cancellation is received by LdM before the start of the program.
